"NO GREATER ENEMY"

2 Timothy 1:7 "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

The Klingon Warf of Star Trek—"There is no greater enemy then one's own fears."

I have chosen to begin this article with 2 quotes, one is inspired by the Holy Spirit, and one, of course, is not. That is obvious. However, they both speak truth. However, it could be argued that our own flesh may be our greatest enemy, but that may be another topic.

Let me begin by saying, I can appreciate Warf's perspective. I have a phobia. It may seem trivial to you, but for me it is real. I have a deep-seated fear of needles. I admit I have an irrational fear of needles! I know it is irrational, but that doesn't mean it is not real. It certainly is for me! I cannot sit beside my dear wife as she sews on our couch. My point is that fear is not a good thing. It can keep us from doing what is right. To be sure, fearing our Creator is good and it is just. Jesus confirmed this in Matt 10:28 ²⁸ "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." However, we are warned many times that we should not fear anything of this world. Why? Because it can cause us to do wrong.

I know the apostle Peter was one of the Lord's closest disciples. However, Peter feared in at least 3 instances, and his fear led to wrongdoing on his part. He started to sink into the water because he grew afraid of the wind and the waves. He also denied Jesus 3 times at Jesus' trial. To highlight his failure after denying Jesus 3 times, he ran away and wept! However, his fear was so great and it had such a hold on him that he did not repent until after Jesus resurrected. Peter also played the part of a hypocrite when he separated himself from christian gentiles for the sake of his fellow Jewish christians. In all these instances I believe their root that led to failure was fear. Perhaps it was even Paul who had fear when he asked the Lord to take away his "thorn of the flesh." I cannot be sure, but I would not be surprised.

Let us all work to drive away our fears. Let us learn how dangerous they can be to our spirits. The best way to drive away our fears is to draw closer to the Lord and what He wants from us. To love him and His people will help drive away our fears.
